The Center for Healthy Minds and Practice, or CHaMP, will serve as a safe, confidential place for all employees to receive wellness and mental health support. It is located in the former cancer building just north of the South Garage on Jefferson Street — near the former bank on the first floor of the parking garage. The building is centrally located, yet has discrete access. CHaMP's mission is to:

- Provide free, confidential and unlimited behavioral therapy to all employees
- Provide crisis-response services to averse events on campus
- Develop and maintain a peer-support counseling network to widen the available safety net to employees experiencing acute adversity
- Provide educational and outreach services, including workshops on resiliency and information about other hospital and community services
